"Wanita Anggun & Hebat" Conference, Penangah

St. Patrick's Sri Indah (Anglican School), Tawau

St. Patrick's Sri Indah (Anglican School) is a God-driven project according to His own timing. Our vision is to champion the success of students through quality education and character building training which will cater the needs for students of all races from Primary 1 to Form 5. One of our objectives is to provide well-rounded education that is using the National Curriculum relevant to the National Philosophy of Education for the achievement of Vision 2020. We aim to promote the employability of the students as well as to ensure holistic student development.

The framework of this school is to provide student-centered teaching and learning experience with the use of Information Communication Technology (ICT) and bilingual medium. On top of that, the main concept is based on the integration of interdisciplinary elements of academics and character building education. The project will be implemented in phases with modern outlook and a conducive ambience.



Anglican Educational Village, Sandakan



With the encouragement of the Bishop, and the support of the Diocesan Education Board, the Anglican churches in Sandakan have embarked on a Taman Pendidikan Anglikan (or 'Anglican Educational Village'). To be built on a 28-acre land given by the government at Sibuga, Sandakan, the whole project will eventually comprise of a kindergarten, a primary school, a secondary school and a junior college.

Hostel and sports facilities will be added to make the 'village' a place where a child could develop his or her God-given potentials. The child will be given the opportunity to spend his or her formative years (from kindergarten to Form 6) in a community and an environment where faith is nurtured, learning is imparted and life is mentored. 'It takes a village to train a child'.

The first phase consists of a kindergarten, a primary school, a multi-purpose hall and some basic sports facilities. The other facilities will be built in later phases. Phase 1 alone is estimated at RM7 million.
